Data protection compliance	Full UK GDPR compliance with documented DPAs, sub-processor agreements and DPIA documentation.
Age-appropriate design	Leadership and governance tool — not designed for direct pupil use.
Avoiding bias	Regular bias review of AI outputs with named board-level accountability for AI ethics.
